



1. BIODIVERSITY

SUPPORTING AMBITIOUS UN NEGOTIATIONS

Urgency

The Global Biodiversity Framework (GBF) sets high goals that now require decisive action. CEMUNE will support summit Presidencies and Co-Chairs through advice and capacity building.

Target Group

Summit Presidencies and Co-Chairs of the UN Biodiversity Conferences in 2026 & 2028
>> 2 Summit Presidents
>> 30 Presidency Team Members
>> 3 - 4 groups of 25 Co-Chairs each

Goal & Impact

1. Enable Presidencies to achieve ambitious results in the SDGs.
2. Long-term impact on global biodiversity and sustainable capacity building in supported governments.

2. UN PLASTICS TREATY

SUPPORTING PROGRESSIVE NEGOTIATORS

Urgency

Despite the 2022 breakthrough in the Global Plastics Treaty, differences remain. CEMUNE supports negotiators from developing countries to ensure ambitious outcomes.

Target Group

Developing countries like Rwanda, Peru, and Fiji, as well as potential hosts for future negotiations
>> 2 - 6 groups with up to 20 negotiators each

Goal & Impact

1. Building negotiation skills in developing countries with global impact on the SDGs.
2. Long-term impact on the Plastics Treaty and future negotiations.

3. AFRICA'S VOICE

IN SOLVING GLOBAL CHALLENGES

Urgency

Africa is heavily affected by environmental and climate crises but often lacks the resources to play a strong role in negotiations. CEMUNE will support African negotiators, including the chairs of the African Group of Negotiators (AGN) from Kenya and Tanzania.

Target Group

Chairs of the AGN, their teams, and leading African negotiators ahead of the UN Climate Summits COP30 in Brazil (2025) & COP31 in Australia (2026)
>> 2 Chair
>> 5 - 6 Team Members
>> 30 - 40 Negotiators

Goal & Impact

1. Strengthening Africa's role in environmental negotiations with global impacts on the SDGs.
2. Long-term outcomes in many environmental agreements and sustainable capacity building for future African negotiators.
